Graduates of the CUPP Program have gone on to enrol and graduate from the Institute of Public Administration, Cabinet of Ministers, Ukraine; take up employment with the Foreign Affairs Department of Ukraine; receive scholarships to Harvard University Summer School; receive Edmund S. Muskie scholarships for graduate studies abroad; receive scholarships to pursue graduate degrees at the University of Chicago Law School and the University of Connecticut Law School; graduate from Roosevelt University, summa cum laude and return to Ukraine; serve as official translator in Crimea for delegation of Western Parliamentarians; apply for the Walter Surma Tarnopolsky Award; and intern at the Institut International des Droits de l'Homme in Strausburg, France.
