- Oct. 7-9, 1994
LANGUAGES AND CULTURES KYIV '94:
1st International Festival of Languages and Cultures
First major international event in Ukraine devoted to Education, Cultures, Languages and Manpower Training held under the auspices of the Secretary General of the Council of Europe, the Ukrainian Ministry of Education and the UNESCO National Commission of Ukraine. Includes a series of conferences on education, a festival of languages and cultures and an exhibition. (Sponsors: Ukrainian Ministry of Culture/Education, Ukrainian House and Ukrainian Cultural Foundation). Also special educational equipment exhibition. (Sponsor: Slavonic Centre)
- Oct. 20, 1994
3rd Conference of Small Businesses of Ukraine.

The program of the Lawyers Congress will deal with the key issues facing the legal profession in Ukraine, including the Constitution and progress on legal and free market reforms. Invited guest speakers to the Lawyers Congress is former British Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher. Other speakers are Ambassador Volodymyr Vassylenko (Belgium), Mr. Justice Michael Kirby (Australia) and Canada's Dr. Dmytro Cipywnyk, President of the World Congress of Ukrainians. Delegates to the Congress from Ukraine will be elected from each region of Ukraine as well as delegates from the cities of Kyiv and Sevastopol. Delegates from the UK, US, France, Argentina, Paraguay, Australia and Canada are expected to actively participate in the Congress.
